Organizational Background

Founded in 1985, New Covenant Christian School is an educational ministry of New Covenant Christian Church. Our Pre-K to 12 institution, with three locations in the Bronx, is a place where students of all backgrounds can learn, grow, and develop in a Christ-centered environment with a commitment to excellence.

Job Description

We seek 2 qualified education professionals to serve as subject teachers for the upcoming 2016-2017 school year. Each teacher will be responsible for teaching two of the following 4 subjects:

- Middle School English
- Middle School Math
- Middle School Social Studies
- High School Biology

The following is general description of the duties, subject to finalization upon hire.

Responsibilities:

- Teach classes as assigned following prescribed scope and sequence as scheduled by the principal.
- Plan broadly through the use of semester and quarterly plans and objectives, and more currently through the use of a Lesson Plan Book.
- Employ a variety of instructional aids, methods, and materials that will provide for creative teaching to reach the whole child: spiritual, mental, physical, social, and emotional.
- Integrate Biblical principles and the Christian philosophy of education throughout the curriculum.
- Effect student learning through mastery of the subject material by utilizing valid teaching techniques to achieve curriculum goals within the framework of the school's philosophy.
- Plan through approved channels the balanced use of field trips, guest speakers, and other media.
- Use homework assignments effectively for drill, review, and enrichment.
- Assess the learning of students on a regular basis and provides progress reports as required.
- Keep proper discipline in the classroom and on the school premises for a good teaching environment.
- Maintain regular and accurate attendance and grade records to meet the demands for a comprehensive knowledge of each student's progress.
- Keep students, parents, and the administration adequately informed of progress or deficiencies and gives sufficient notice of failure.
- Prepare class to make a presentation in the annual Christmas and Easter programs.

- Supervise extra-curricular activities, organizations, and outings as assigned.
- Maintain a clean, attractive, well-ordered classroom.
- Utilize educational opportunities and evaluation processes for professional growth.
- Perform any other duties which may be assigned by the administration.

Required Qualifications

- Must possess at least a Bachelor's degree in education, child development, or a related field. Masters Degree a plus.
- Must be a born-again believer in Jesus Christ and actively involved in a church body.
- Must have at least 1 year of lead teacher experience in a classroom.

Compensation: \$18,000 to \$20,000, commensurate with education and experience.
